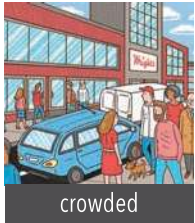

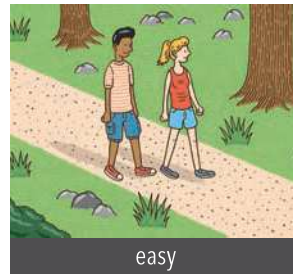

### Notes

- To form the simple past, use base form of the verb + **-ed**: *cleaned*.
- For verbs that end in **e**, use base form + **d**: *danced*.
- Use the base form of the verb with *did / didn't*: *I didn't walk to school*.

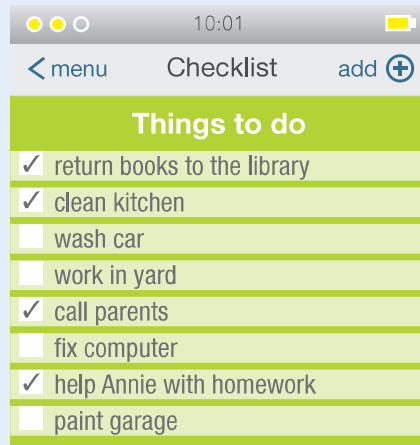

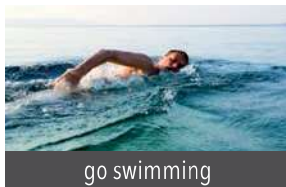

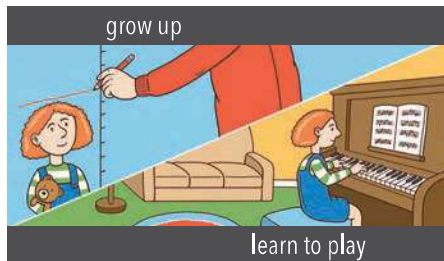

### Notes

- We almost always use the contraction *didn't* in informal writing and speaking.
- To ask questions with *born*, you can say *Where were you born?* or *Were you born in New York?*
